The mean anti-emetic dose in all patients for breakthrough CINV pre-implementation was 4.837 ± 10.4857 . Post-implementation, the mean anti-emetic dose for all patients was 3.394 ± 6.432 . This was not statistically significant ($p = 0.462$). For patients under 12, the mean anti-emetic dose pre-implementation was 5.8 ± 12.5333 and post-implementation was 3.882 ± 8.1 . This was also not statistically significant ($p = 0.55$). Data collected from this project did demonstrate a decrease in the number of breakthrough anti-emetics used in children under 12 years of age likely related to the addition of the drug aprepitant.
