would. As she tries to regain her memory and slowly steps into her role as a wife and mother, Eli helps her readjust to daily life with sometimes-hilarious, sometimes-heartwarming results. But can she fall in love again with a man she can't remember? Will their secrets destroy them . . . or has erasing the past given them a chance for a future?

The Shadow of the Sun Feb 21 2022 Ryszard Kapuscinski has been writing about the people of Africa throughout his career.
