NOAA Fines, Penalties, and Forfeiture Fund (the Fund) is the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act (MFCMA), the primary law governing commercial fishing in the United States. In November, 1990, Congress greatly expanded the Fund authority. The Fund contains fines, penalties, and proceeds of forfeited assets that are collected by the Secretary of Commerce for violations of marine resource laws. There are no appropriated monies in the Fund. The MFCMA provides specific guidance about how Fund monies can be spent. Expenditures are restricted to certain purposes relating to law enforcement and prosecution. Since the Fund's inception in 1990, deposits have been about \$24.8 M of which about \$21.6 M has been spent. Accordingly, the Fund now has a balance of \$3.2 M"--Introduction.
